Some of the requirements of being able to bowl are following rules pertaining to each individual participating in bowling.

- Arc Members you are participating at your own discretion and liability. The Arc of Laramie County will take extra precautions to ensure that you are able to safely bowl, however you are responsible for yourself and your wellbeing. Masks are highly recommended and hand sanitizer will be available. Social distancing should be maintained as much as possible. While we recommend the use of face masks we cannot guarantee everyone will use them. To see Two Bar's COVID 19 protocols or to learn more please visit their website at http://www.2barbowl.com/. We will be following any rules they have in place. By participating you agree to not hold The Arc of Laramie County responsible if you become ill. The Arc will keep contact information on all bowlers and staff. If you become ill at any point during the season you will need to contact us.
- If you are ill with any sickness, please stay home!!! There will be other bowling dates. Face masks are to be worn at your lane. We highly recommend that you wear a face mask at all times while in the building.
- Unfortunately, due to COVID 19 we will not be allowing you to pick which team you bowl on. <u>This</u> rule is only in effect for the 2021 season as of now. You will be placed on a team based on the order in which you call to sign up.
- 4. Depending on the number of bowlers we may be running two sessions. Check in will begin for each session 20 minutes before your start time. Please do not arrive any earlier than 30 minutes before the start of your bowling time. Example: 1st session will check-in at 12:40pm, bowling at 1:00pm, 2nd session will check in at 2:30pm, bowling at 3:00pm. Times will be assigned. Do not arrive prior to 12:30pm or 2:30pm. If you do arrive early please wait in your vehicles.
- 5. No extra spectators will be allowed. Only the required staff/supports should attend with you. If your friends aren't bowling, leave them home and make arrangements to see them another time.
- 6. Only participants that are bowling will be allowed to be in the bowling area to sit. Please make sure you are sitting at the table that corresponds with your lane. All support staff need seated in the upper level tables to watch participants. Please only bring/send the necessary number of support staff or providers needed to assist bowlers.
- 7. Everyone will use appropriate language and behaviors when interacting with others. We will not use: Profanity, put downs, insults, name calling, bulling, harassment, or anything that might cause another person to feel uncomfortable. We will not rough house or horseplay while in the bowling alley.
- 8. Please help keep the bowling alley clean by cleaning up all trash and putting away chairs that you may get out. The bowling alley and The Arc shouldn't have to clean up after you. Everyone including provider's need to pitch in to ensure the bowling alley is put back the way we found it. Messes will not be tolerated.
- 9. <u>All Shoes will be untied and turned into the front desk. All balls will be put in the appropriate places. If you get a ball out it is your responsibility to put the ball back. Providers attending need to ensure the individuals you are responsible for are putting their balls away.</u>
- 10. <u>Our main goal is to keep everyone safe! We know all these rules are not ideal but given the</u> current conditions we are doing the best we can so that we can allow bowling to happen! If you have questions please contact us at 307-632-1209.
